The following conditions apply to this permit:

1. In accordance with City Ordinances, burning may begin at 7:00 a.m. with all fires completely extinguished, no smoldering, one half hour before dark. Burn barrels and incinerators are prohibited. Fire must be 15' from all structures.
2. Fire must be attended by a competent person at all times until fire is extinguished. A garden hose or other means of extinguishments must be readily available at all times.
3. Plant material grown on property (leaves, twigs, branches, weeds, etc.) as well as untreated wood products may be burned.
4. No rubbish may be burned. Rubbish is defined as: combustible and non-combustible waste materials, including residue from the burning of coal, wood, coke, or other combustible materials paper, rags, cartons, tin cans, metals, mineral matter, glass crockery, dust and discarded refrigerators, and heating, cooking, or incinerator-type appliances.
5. Prohibited items shall also include food products, plastics, treated wood products, roofing materials, grass clippings, cardboard, newspaper, or any other substance, which would create offensive or unhealthful emissions.
6. Burning shall not take place if there is excessive wind or if an Air Quality Advisory has been issued by the Idaho Division of Environmental Quality. Please call DEQ at 208-373-0313 for Air Quality status prior to burning.
7. Notify Canyon County Dispatch, 208-454-7531 as to time and place of burn.
8. Call 911 if trouble is encountered.
9. Must have a copy of this permit on hand.

Failure to comply with the conditions of this permit may result in a billing from the Fire Department at the rate of \$75.00 per apparatus hour of part thereof.
